



Alex Glass was appointed as the Indiana Securities Commissioner by Indiana Secretary of State Connie Lawson in July 2015. As Commissioner, Glass is responsible for upholding Indiana's securities laws, regulating industry professionals and protecting investors. Glass is an active member of the North American Securities Administrators Association (NASAA) and currently serves as Chair of the Investment Adviser Section and sits on the Senior Issues/Diminished Capacity board level committee. In 2019, Glass was appointed to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission Asset Management Advisory Committee. Glass is also a member of the advisory board for the Indiana Council for Economic Education (ICEE) and the NASAA Seniors Advisory Council.

Prior to his appointment, Glass worked in the Securities Division in multiple capacities starting in 2010, including serving as the Chief Deputy Securities Commissioner from January 2013 until his appointment. As Chief Deputy, Glass was instrumental in setting internal and external office policy and upgrading the Division's technology systems. Prior to joining the office, Glass worked as Director of Operations at a marketing research company in Carmel.

Glass is a graduate of the Indiana University Kelley School of Business and the Indiana University McKinney School of Law. Glass is a native of Fort Wayne and currently resides in Westfield.
